<u>Technology Definitions – Training provided for ITALICIZED items</u>

- Distance Learning Tools D2L, Kaltura Mediaspace
 - D2L Brightspace Online Learning Management System used for classroom instruction. Syllabus, coursework, and quizzes are some of the resources that can be housed here.
 - Kaltura Mediaspace Tool to Record and share lectures and capture screen presentations. Link to captured media via D2L.
- Web-based Conferencing Tools Zoom, Microsoft Teams, Skype for Business
 - Skype for Business effective chat tool for quick conversations with MinnState employees.
 - Teams Part of the Office 365 software group allows for file distribution, chat & video conferencing to communicate with students, faculty, and staff.
 - Zoom video conference/phone conference online tool to communicate with students, faculty, and staff. Allows for non-MinnState members to easily connect to conversations.

- Remote/Telework Tools VPN, Remote Desktop, Softphone
 - Remote Desktop Computer-based application that allows you to connect to a computer from off-campus. AR-Slate is used in conjunction with VPN in some cases.
 - Softphone Computer-based application (Jabber) that allows any computer to replicate your physical work phone on a computer.
 - VPN (Virtual Private Network) Allows users to access institution resources that are restricted to ON-Campus use. ISRS, Marketplace, and Softphones are examples of applications that need VPN access.
- Business Applications Everyday functional tools
 - OneDrive Part of the Office 365 software group File and folders which allow users to connect to documents anywhere there is a network connection.
